Along the way we'll learn first-hand about the history of Maine's lighthouses, why they are located where they are, how they influenced commerce along Maine's unforgiving rocky coast, how keepers and their families survived for months at a time in remote locations and how these lighthouses remain important aids to navigation.

#### NATURE AND PHOTOGRAPHY

Grab your camera and binoculars for this 6day sailing adventure. Capture the joy of nature and enjoy the thrill of sailing through Maine's pristine island archipelago rich with wildlife and textured by dramatic island geology. We'll see what is possible with a very modest digital camera. As we'll learn, photography is all about using light to effectively convey stories and ideas. With a few simple tricks today's cell phone technology introduces a whole new creative opportunity. The week features a fun-filled evening of work created by participants aboard. Our naturalist will help us appreciate the mega and micro fauna that make Maine one of the East coast's most naturally vibrant areas to explore. Celebrate the longest days of the year exploring islands and intertidal ecology ashore while capturing beautiful images sailing along one of the planet's most scenic coastlines aboard one of Maine's celebrated windjammers.

### TALLSHIP SAILING & SEAMANSHIP COURSE

We invite you to join us for a week of experiential instruction aboard one of Penobscot Bay's legendary tall ships, the schooner Mary Day. Launched in 1962 the schooner is 90' on deck, 125' sparred length, displaces 96 tons, and carries 5,200 sq. ft. of canvas with more sails than any other schooner on the bay. She is a big, fast, traditional coasting schooner built specifically for carrying guests with comfort and safety in mind. With no inboard engine sailing is how we get to where we are going. Sailing is both a practice and a process. Though you may not have your own tallship at home, the skills and decision making process you learn aboard Mary Day readily translates from one boat to another.

During this 'hands-on' team-oriented course, students will become integral members of *Mary Day*'s crew. Topics covered will include general seamanship, coastal navigation, and marlinespike seamanship. Students will be divided into teams to learn the skills that every sailor needs aboard any vessel. We'll learn about points of sail, effectively tacking upwind, safely gybing down wind, running before the wind wing and wing, backing down under sail, standing watches and navigating in restricted visibility. The crew of *Mary Day* will expertly guide you in trimming and handling sails, steering, The rhythm of shipboard life provides a unique environment to experience the sights, sounds and smells of the Maine coastline. Most importantly, we'll bring humor, joy, and a "noyelling" relaxed atmosphere to the learning experience. Join the crew of *Mary Day* for a great week under sail discovering the inner workings of a traditional sailing ship.

The Camden Windjammer Festival celebrates the 1936 founding of the windjammer

industry right here in Camden with concerts, plays, a schooner talent show composed of guests and crew for the privilege of flying the coveted Schooner Talent Show banner. We will join the other windjammers in a parade of sail into Camden harbor on Friday afternoon, where we will all raft up for the evening. Without question, you will witness the largest gathering of windjammer passenger vessels this side of the known universe. Guests should plan to stay aboard to enjoy Friday night dinner, the fireworks display and Saturday brunch at no extra charge.

#### WOODENBOAT RENDEZVOUS CRUISE

Celebrate the season's final gathering of Maine's tall-ship fleet at the home of *WoodenBoat* magazine. This is a great chance to explore the WoodenBoat School's workshops. Come join us as we converge in a parade of sail in Eggemoggin Reach before anchoring for the afternoon in the harbor at WoodenBoat. Big beautiful sailing vessels with a Maine coast backdrop will create many great images for you to capture so bring your camera!

Reservation/cancellation policy: In order to keep our cost to you as low as possible and maintain fairness, reservations are taken on a first-come, first-served basis.
